In 2009, the Winnipeg Winter Women's Open Pro Tournament made its debut in Winnipeg. Brenda is responsible in making arrangements with the host club and contacting all recipients as well as organizing the awards.

Brenda was a member of the 2001 Westerns Committee responsible for player recruitment.

Brenda has also committed to research Squash Manitoba's archives and put together our History of Squash in Manitoba. As part of this endeavour she is involved in the creation of Manitoba Squash Hall of Fame.

Brenda has also contributed as an A level player and Master athlete in Manitoba. Brenda has been on the Manitoba Masters representing our province since 2001 to present. Brenda is a dedicated athlete who is a hard worker and a team player. Brenda was also a mentor for the 2001-2003 Canada Winter Games & Junior Provincial Teams. Brenda also participated in the Women's Team league from 2001-2010 (always a captain). Brenda also took the NCCP Intro to Squash course.
